Dear Parent / Carer,

I am delighted to write to you with good news about the recent fundraising activities that we have been running. At the Quiz and Band Night on the 31<sup>st</sup> January we were able to raise just under £800 towards the cost of kit and equipment. Thank you to all parents and students that got involved in any way; by attending the evening, providing raffle prizes or purchasing raffle tickets. Atop of this, thanks to all that provided cake for the bake sale on Wednesday and Thursday last week. When combining the two amounts, it is likely that we have got just over one thousand pounds. We will now start to plan to purchase garments for each of the students involved.

Now that our fundraising has run its course, we turn our attention to putting together the final organisational points of the trip. In order to provide you with an idea of the finer details of the trip, we would like to invite all parents and students to meeting at 6pm on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> February. At this meeting, we will be able to give final details of timings, baggage allowances and contact details for when we are away. If you are unable to attend, please let me know by email (below) and I will send the relevant information home. In order to start the process of collecting information, I have enclosed with this letter a comprehensive document provided by Inspiresport, which asks for lots of passport details, medical conditions and personal contacts. If you could fill out these details and return this to the school office as soon as possible, it would be greatly appreciated. At the latest, we would like all medical / passport information handed in by the end of the parents meeting.

As well as a valid passport, all travelling students will need to have a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) in case of any medical attention being required. These can be obtained free of charge from (<https://www.ehic.org.uk/Internet/startApplication.do>) and normally take about ten days to process and arrive. At the meeting, we aim to collect all passports and EHIC Cards. If you are away during the first part of the Easter holiday (and require your passports) please let us know! Likewise, if the application for obtaining an EHIC takes longer than normal, then we shall collect those at a later date.

Lastly, just a quick reminder that the last instalment of the payment towards the trip is due this Friday – allowing us to pay up the final balance with Inspiresport during half term.
