Dear Parent / Carers,

I am delighted to write to you in offering the opportunity to take part in a trip to Old Trafford to watch Soccer Aid 2014 on Sunday 8th June. The trip is open to all students in Years 7 – 10 and I would encourage all students to take this fantastic chance to witness a charity game like no other!

Soccer Aid is now established as a biennial event, which aims to raise as much money as possible for the great work that UNICEF do changing the lives of children all over the world. In fact, since its inception in 2006, Soccer Aid has raised over £12 million for these worthy causes. The match pits celebrities and ex-professional footballers against each in a battle of an England XI versus a Rest of the World XI. So far it has been confirmed that Robbie Williams will once again captain the England side, which also contains celebrities such as Jack Whitehall, John Bishop and Paddy McGuinness. They will be supported by the England legends; Jamie Redknapp, Jamie Carragher and David Seaman amongst others. The Rest of the World XI will be managed by the current Chelsea manager, Jose Mourinho whilst his squad features the likes of Edwin van der Sar and Edgar Davids alongside their celebrity colleagues such as Patrick Kielty and Gordon Ramsay.

The price of the trip is just £20 per student and includes return coach travel to Manchester and a ticket (seated in the Stretford End) for the match. We shall leave York at about 4pm and travel to Manchester leaving enough time to explore, purchase food and enter the ground before kick-off at 8pm. Upon the completion of the game, we shall travel back to York and hope to arrive at Fulford before midnight.

If you are interested in your son / daughter taking part, please do not hesitate to return the attached slip and monies to the school office before Monday 19th May. Cheques are to be made payable to 'Fulford School Fund.' We do expect a large amount of interest in this trip, despite it being during the weekend. If we are oversubscribed with interest, this may result in us having to pick names out of a hat. However, if all students that wish to go on the trip register their interest early enough, we may be able to increase our allocation of tickets.
