Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of the Alternative Curriculum Day on October 18th the Science department will be taking year 10 students to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park. The educational focus of the trip will be to enhance student understanding of animal adaptations, habitat and conservation. These are important aspects of the Biology syllabus that have been taught recently.

Further details about the park can be found at www.yorkshirewildlifepark.com. Students will have the opportunity to attend a number of presentations during the day relating to different animals, such as 'Big Bugs Live' for example.

This trip will run within the normal school day with coaches leaving at 9:00am and returning at 3:10pm. Students should wear a school uniform top (to aid identification at the park) and will need a packed lunch, drink and a small bag/rucksack to carry a suitable coat, notebook and pen. Students may also wish to bring a mobile phone as we will be running a photograph competition as part of the day. Please note that the school is unable to accept any responsibility for such items, which students bring at their own risk.

All students have access to our extra-curricular activities and reasonable adjustments will be made to ensure each student's full inclusion in this trip. Please contact Mr Bodey, Deputy Headteacher, if you think that this may be needed for your child.

Under the terms of the Education Reform Act 1996 the school cannot make a direct charge for the trip. We are however permitted to ask for voluntary contributions towards the Yorkshire Wildlife Park visit. Please note we are unable to subsidise this visit from other school funds. We reserve the right to cancel the visit if insufficient funds are available. If your child is eligible for Learner Support Fund, simply return the reply slip below indicating this is the case.

The cost for the trip is **£14.50** and **ParentPay** can be used to make this contribution by **Wednesday 10th October** (alternatively cash or a check made payable to 'Fulford School Fund' is acceptable). Consent slips should also be returned to the **main school office** by this date.
