Revision Skills morning: Monday 17th March

We are pleased to inform you that Fulford School has brought in the services of a well renowned study skills company, Learning Performance Seminars, to assist your son/daughter with his/her revision skills. This has been possible through the school's Maths and Computing Specialist Status. Revision skills are an area where students and parents consistently ask for support and we are delighted to be able to offer students this.

During the morning, students will benefit from 2 hours with Learning Performance Seminars followed by 4 half-hours sessions with the Directors of Learning focusing on other ways in which to best revise. In the afternoon, students will attend their final Progress Review meeting, for which more information will follow shortly.

We believe that this will complement the work being done by form tutors helping students prepare for revision. Please be aware that revision classes have also started in a range of subjects (please see the VLE for details) and would encourage students to attend these.

The parent session will run as a one hour seminar on Monday 17th March from 6.00-7.00pm and aims to "enable parents to take a productive role in supporting their children's academic life" and give an understanding of the key revision skills used by students.
