All students have access to our extra-curricular activities and reasonable adjustments will be made to ensure each student's full inclusion in this trip. Please contact Mr Bodey, Deputy Headteacher, if you think that this may be needed for your child.

All payments can be made online through ParentPay using your username and password. You can also pay by cheque. This should be made payable to "Fulford School Fund" and write Leeds and your child's name and form on the back. This should be handed in to the school reception by **Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> October**. Under the terms of the Education Reform Act 1996 the school cannot make a direct charge for the trip. We are, however, permitted to ask for voluntary contributions towards the Leeds interfaith visit. Please note we are unable to subsidise this visit from other school funds.
