Year 7 “History of York” Bus Tour

The History department are running an exciting educational visit this term, and we would like to let you know about it as soon as possible.

The course your son/daughter will be studying for the first half term is based on the “Horrible History of York” looking at how the city we live in has changed through the ages. As part of this course we have organised an open top bus tour of the city for all year 7’s to help them understand what they are learning in the classroom.

Your son/daughter will participate in one of the tours, which will take place on **Tuesday 16 September** for the e half of the year and **Wednesday 17 September** for the h half of the year and will run from 1.10pm until 2.30pm. As this is over school lunchtime this means that students will only miss a few minutes of lesson time. It does, however, mean that your son/daughter will need to bring a packed lunch to school on the day of their tour as we have permission from the bus company for students to eat lunch on the bus during the journey.

Students who are entitled to free school meals will be able to arrange collection of a packed lunch earlier in the school day.

The cost of the bus tour will be £4.50 as a special rate has been negotiated with the bus company. This is non-refundable. Please return the permission slip for the trip along with payment, either as cash or a cheque payable to “Fulford School Fund” in an envelope labelled with your child’s name, form and History of York Tour. As the visit takes place shortly we would appreciate return of the money by **Thursday 11 September** at the latest.
