Re: Chemistry at Work, Mon 10th July 2017

York University, in partnership with NYBEP, are offering 60 of our year 9 students the opportunity to participate in an event designed to stimulate an interest in Science: Chemistry at Work. Students will experience a lecture and 4 workshops which aim to present the principles of chemistry as they are applied in industry, research and everyday life. This will illustrate the importance of the academic study of Science and highlight a variety of careers available in a wide range of contexts.

Students will come to Fulford School as normal in the morning and meet at reception to be registered. We will then walk to the University with the first lecture commencing at 10:00am. The event will finish in time for us to walk back to school with normal arrangements being in place for getting home. Students will need to wear normal school uniform and bring their usual equipment. As we will be working in laboratories it is important that students are appropriately covered, for example wearing trousers (lab coats will also be used) with long hair tied back. Students will need to bring their own packed lunch and a drink.

All students have access to our extra-curricular activities and reasonable adjustments will be made to ensure each student's full inclusion in this trip. Please contact Mr Bodey, Deputy Headteacher, if you think that this may be needed for your child.
