Re: Villarreal 2016

With the visit less than a week away I writing to you with the final information for the trip.

If your child requires medication whilst on the visit please hand it in to the main office before Wednesday 23 March. I also need any spare inhalers.

I hope you all agree with me that £100 is enough for spending money (remember it must be in euros!) as well as some English currency for the journey.

Students may wish to bring some food for the journey but can I remind you liquids should not be taken though customs. Please see attached information on baggage allowances for Monarch.

Your son/daughter may also wish to bring electrical items with them but please be aware they do so at their own risk and own insurance.

The kit will be given out on the Wednesday prior to departure. Please could students remember to wear the hoody, tracksuit bottoms and the polo shirt to travel in. Please don't wear the training/playing top. If pupils could bring navy and white football socks and blue shorts on the trip that would be great so we have the same for the matches.

Finally please remember to drop your child off at 3am prompt for a 3.30am departure. Please do not arrive any earlier than this to lessen the disruption to the residents of Fulfordgate.

Baggage Allowances – Monarch

Checked Baggage

Every passenger has a maximum of 20kg of hold/checked-in baggage

Hand Baggage

One piece of hand baggage no bigger than 56 x 40 x 25cm (there will be a size gauge at the airport to check this) and no heavier than 10 kilos, plus a small duty free bag from the departure airport.

Or

Two separate pieces of hand baggage, as long as the combined size is no bigger than 56 x 40 x 25cm and the combined weight no heavier than 10 kilos, plus a small duty free bag from the departure airport.

Unfortunately, regardless of our policy, Luton Airport only allows one piece of hand baggage through security. This is out of our control and we are working with Luton to resolve this.

All we ask is that you put small items under the seat in front of you, to leave more space in the overhead lockers for larger bags.

If your hand baggage **does not** comply with the restrictions, you will be **charged** at the departure gate and your baggage will be placed in the hold.

Liquids

Some liquids are allowed through airport security check points. There are however, restrictions on the quantity of liquids that can be taken through:

Passengers may carry small quantities of liquids, but only within separate containers each of which with a capacity not greater than 100ml.

These containers must be brought to the airport contained in a single, transparent, re-sealable plastic bag (about the size of a small freezer bag), which itself must not exceed 1 litre in capacity (approximately 20cm x 20cm). The contents of the plastic bag must fit comfortably and the bag sealed. Each passenger may carry only one such bag of liquids which must fit comfortably within the single permitted item of hand baggage.

The bag must be presented separately for examination at the airport security point.

Please note: - Any containers larger than 100ml (excluding essential medicines, see website for further details) will NOT be allowed through the security search point. - Most liquids of any amount may still be carried in hold baggage.

Remember that 'Liquids' includes: *All drinks, including water, soup, syrups. *Creams, lotions, oils, perfumes, mascara etc. *Sprays and pressurized containers including shaving foam and spray deodorants. *Pastes, including toothpaste* Gels, including hair and shower gel *Any other solutions and items of similar consistency

Please note that liquids can usually be purchased beyond airport security search points, in the departures area, as these liquids are subject to a separate screening process.
