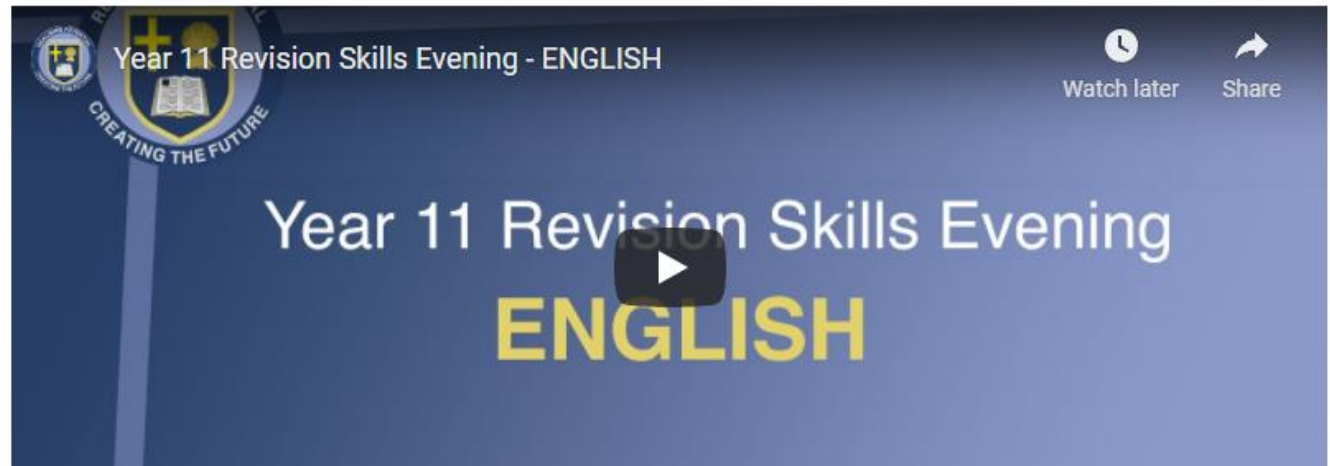

# Examinations Summer 2022

## What we do know

- \* Reduced content in English Literature, Geography, History and Imedia
- \* Unit grades awarded for BTEC Enterprise for the units unable to be assessed in Year 10
- \* Art will be assessed purely on the portfolio element of the course
- \* NEA (Coursework) completed as usual with relevant adjustments to take into account impact of Covid.



# Examinations Summer 2022

## What we do know

- \* GCSEs planned to run between Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May and Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> June
- \* Contingency Date Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> June
- \* Release of advance information (by February 2022) on the focus of the content of summer 2022 exams for all GCSE subjects except for Art, Geography, History and English Literature.
- \* Timing of core exams planned to ensure sufficient gaps between exams to allow students to have sat at least one paper if they have to isolate at any point.



# Examinations Summer 2022

## What we do know

- \* There will be contingency arrangements in the event that exams do not run in Summer 2022.
- \* Consultation closed last week
- \* Likelihood is that this will be a similar process to the 2021 grading.
- \* Proposal is that if exams in Summer 2022 do not take place then mock exams will be used to support awarding of the final grade.



# Mock Exams



- Two sets of mock exams
- Set 1: 22<sup>nd</sup> November to 3<sup>rd</sup> December
- Set 2: 28<sup>th</sup> February to 9<sup>th</sup> March
- Each student will be given their own statement of entry for these exams.
- This will say time and venue of each of their exam and give their seat number. These will be given out in form periods. Stick it on the fridge and ask students to take a picture of it!
- A text will be sent home to inform parents when these are issued.





# The Exam Rooms

- \* During the exam period only year 11 students are using the exam rooms
- \* Desks are spaced 1.25m apart
- \* Touch points are cleaned regularly
- \* Invigilators have had specific training
- \* Students must not take phones or watches into the exam rooms
- \* Pencil cases must be see through
- \* Students can take water into the exam rooms
- \* Students should bring their own equipment to the exams



# Unwell Students

- \* Where a student is unwell we will try to make arrangements for them to complete the exam that they have missed on their return to school.
- \* Where a student is absent for an extended period, we will re-schedule their exams so that they can complete them on their return to school
- \* In some cases it will not be possible for them to complete all the exams that they have missed. We will prioritise them being able to complete at least one exam in each subject.





# Mock Examination Results

- \* Issued by class teachers as soon as they have been moderated.
- \* Use the outcomes and the targets to identify what needs to be improved.
- \* Sent home on reports in January.
- \* Mock results help to decide upon post-16 courses but look at predicted grades closely as well.
